

Hot Metal Bridge Application Instructions

Please read the application checklist for what must be submitted for each department.

Thank you for your interest in the Hot Metal Bridge Program run by the Kenneth P. Dietrich School of Arts and Sciences graduate programs! To apply for admission, complete the online application through the [ApplyYourself Application Network](#).

Before selecting a department and completing the application, please read the information below for the specific checklist requirements. Questions you may have can be answered by emailing Philippa Carter at hmbp@pitt.edu or calling 412-624-6096.

As part of the application you will be required to select a specialization.

HMB students are not required to pay an application fee. When you are ready to submit your application please select the check option and then do not send a check.

For all applicants to all departments: You must list three recommenders. We will review your application as long as at least two letters of recommendation are submitted by the April 1, 2019 deadline. There are no extensions to the deadline.

When you start the application process you must select as your department or field do you wish to major in? Hot Metal Bridge Program

The Academic Plan must be Hot Metal Bridge Program

Your proposed Area of Specialization is your department of interest. You can select more than one Area of Specialization. They are: Anthropology, Biological Sciences, Chemistry, Economics, History of Art & Architecture, Mathematics, Neuroscience and Psychology.

Biological Sciences:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK (3.0 is recommended GPA but willing to look at applicants with a 2.75 GPA and higher)
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**)
- RÉSUMÉ or CV

Chemistry:

- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK (3.0 is recommended GPA but willing to look at applicants with a 2.75 GPA and higher)
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**)
- OFFICIAL SCORES FROM STANDARDIZED ADMISSIONS EXAMS- GREs (**recommended but not required**)
- RÉSUMÉ or CV

Economics:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK (3.0 is recommended GPA)
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 point and no larger than 12 point**)
- EVIDENCE OF MATHEMATICS COURSEWORK COMPLETED
- OFFICIAL SCORES FROM STANDARDIZED ADMISSIONS EXAMS – GREs (**recommended but not required**)
- RÉSUMÉ or CV

HA&A:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK (3.0 is recommended GPA)
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 point and no larger than 12 point**)
- OFFICIAL SCORES FROM STANDARDIZED ADMISSIONS EXAMS – GREs (**recommended but not required**)
- RÉSUMÉ or CV

Mathematics:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK
- THERE MUST BE EVIDENCE OF MATHEMATICS COURSEWORK (**minimum of least the following courses: Algebra, Calculus and an upper level undergraduate mathematics course**)
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**)

- OFFICIAL SCORES FROM STANDARDIZED ADMISSIONS EXAMS – GREs
(**recommended but not required**)
- RÉSUMÉ or CV

Neuroscience:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR COLLEGE COURSEWORK (recommended cumulative gpa of 3.0 or higher, but will consider applicants who have a 2.75 or higher gpa)
- STATEMENT OF GOALS FOR POSTGRADUATE TRAINING AND FUTURE CAREER (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**)
- SUMMARY OF PRIOR RESEARCH EXPERIENCE (**IF ANY and it must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**)
- OFFICIAL GRE SCORES (**recommended but not required**)
- RESUMÉ OR CV

Psychology:

- COMPLETED APPLICATION
- COPIES OF TRANSCRIPTS OF PRIOR ACADEMIC WORK
- STATEMENT OF ACADEMIC GOALS (**must be no more than two pages doubled-spaced with a font that is no smaller than 10 pt and no larger than 12 point**) THE STATEMENT MUST LIST AT LEAST TWO POSSIBLE MENTORS FROM THE PSYCHOLOGY DEPARTMENT THAT THE STUDENT WISHES TO WORK WITH
- OFFICIAL SCORES FROM STANDARDIZED ADMISSIONS PSYCHOLOGY EXAMS – GREs (**recommended but not required**)
